

BSCC RULES AND MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION 2022-2023



Membership Fee

\$60.00 First horse, \$30 Each additional horse.

Sponsorship – ALL SPONSORSHIP MONEY WILL GO TOWARD AWARDS

Each member is responsible for obtaining and providing to BSCC a \$60.00 Sponsorship or a family of \$90. A family consists of two partners residing in the same household, a parent/guardian and one (1) child or two (2) children under the age of eighteen (18). Each additional family member will be \$30.

Any individual member that obtains a sponsorship of \$1000. will receive their entry fee only waived for Saturday and Sunday of Finals.

Any individual member that obtains a sponsorship of \$500. will receive one day entry fee only waived at Finals paid.

All sponsor money must be received by April 30, 2023 for previous runs to count. If you member after April 30, sponsor money is due within 30 days of date of membership for runs to count.

Qualify for Finals

5 runs qualify 1 horse for finals.

Runs kept on rider and NOT horse(s). If you run one horse 15 times, you qualify 3 horses for finals, with paid memberships and sponsor fees.

Example:

5 runs = 1 horse qualified for finals

10 runs = 2 horses qualified for finals

15 runs = 3 horses qualified for finals etc.

Classes

PEE WEE: 10 and under effective September 1, 2022. If you sign up for the Pee-Wee class, you cannot run any other class. Exempt from BSCC fee.

JUNIOR: 17 and under as of September 1, 2022

NOVICE: Under \$500 on horse or rider

SENIOR: 45 and over

Qualifier Races

If a producer would like to offer a qualifier race, the race must have \$1000 or more added and can be a single day or weekend combined total. Every rider at a qualifier must pay the \$5 fee at a qualifier, all of this will go to BSCC finals. The producer may build this into the entry fee or have it on their form separate but all riders pay the fee. Anyone wanting to member at a qualifier and run, their runs will count as being qualified for our BSCC finals. Memberships must be turned in before the end of the race in order for their runs to count for a qualifier. Membership forms will be available at the race or on our website if you prefer to member up first through the mail.

BSCC Finals Buy In's

BSCC will now allow a "buy in" to finals. Buy In's must be turned in by the cutoff date for finals and follow the pre entry system for finals or be a late enter. Buy in Fee's will be set at \$150. for the rider's membership and sponsorship and one horse, each additional horse would be \$55 plus your total entry fees, and if you choose to late enter there will be a late entry fee. We are allowing buy ins because of the distance for many that cannot make races or qualifiers in our area.

FYI

- BSCC will charge a \$25 draw out fee *(plus any office fees that apply)* to anyone drawing out from the race once entered and a vet or medical slip is required in order to get a refund minus the fees.
- NSF fees - \$50.00 fine and cash only basis for one year.
- If BSCC or any BSCC Producer receives an NSF check and it is not made good by the payor they will be placed on a CASH only basis for the entire year once the check IS cleared up. Until the check is cleared up with any "additional fee" charges you will be ineligible to ride at any BSCC Sanctioned or Co-Sanctioned Race. A notification will be sent out to all producers indicating this specific person is ineligible.
- BSCC and/or producers have the right to refuse any entry.

- No abuse will be tolerated.
- Peewee cannot enter peewee **horse** in any additional classes.
- Horse can be entered no more than twice in any class with different rider.

Prime Races:

All open 4D riders will pay \$5.00 BSCC fee per horse per race at all events throughout the year. No less than \$4.00 will go towards finals added money. Producers have the option keep the \$1.00 to create future races. Races produced by BSCC management will put all \$5.00 towards finals pot.

Co-Sanctioned Races:

All riders wanting their runs to count toward finals will pay the \$5. Co-Sanction fee. The race producer will remit the entire \$5. fee.

There will be no year-end points kept. This is designed strictly for a big, added money finals with great finals awards.

FINALS

Finals will be the weekend of September 8, 9 and 10 at Twisted Bit Arena in Veneta. BSCC will be offer a 5D format for the open at finals. Senior, Youth and Novice will be 4D with a 1 second split. Friday, September 8 will consist of an open warm-up race with a minimum of \$1000. added. The warm-up race is open to non-member riders as well as member riders. Saturday and Sunday September 9 and 10 will both count toward average. Added money to be determined but will be no less than \$4000 per day.

Member only high point saddle – BSCC will give a high point saddle to the three-day high-point earner in the 5D. The points will be calculated from the first 5D race Friday, September 8 and the 5D from Saturday and Sunday. If there is a tie, the tie will be broken by the rider with the most 1st place runs and then go down from there. If there is still a tie, there will be a run-off or coin toss. This will be left up to the riders to determine which they prefer.

Member Only Side-pot – Top 40 members (highest run counts) will be entered into the member only side-pot, no entry fee and \$1500 added money. Riders can buy back in if they hit a barrel. 100% of buy-back money goes into the pot. Buy-back fee is \$35. This will be a 4D with a 1 second split.

If there is a tie for run counts, they will be counted as follows. (Example: You have 3 people with 20 runs and they start at 5th highest. Those riders would be 5, 6 and 7. Rider with 19 runs would be 8). If there is a tie at 40, BSCC will do a random draw to determine who gets to ride in the 40 spot.

Run for the Roses Sidepot - \$1200 added for the run for the roses. Entry fee is \$30.00 with 80% payback and 4D format with a 1 second split. To qualify, your horse must be able to be verified on Equibase or their dam, sire, granddam or grandsire is verifiable on Equibase.
